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



A Patient Called Santa




Dear HOPE participants in Finland,

To the patient/client

- Improve autonomy and independence
- Reduce risk of hospital infections
- Increase patient/client satisfaction

To the Hospital/Healthcare

- Reduce inpatient days/hospital beds
- Reduce costs
- Keep hospital resources for specialist care

Staying at Home

Some initiatives implemented:

Hospital at Home: to provide IV treatments (antibiotics/chemo) under hospital supervisión (hospitalist team). Enlarged timetable (7-21h)

Mallu/Malla: mobile services (dental assistance; lab/ECG; nurses appointments)

Mallu/Malla

Mobile units that go to the patient Using electronic records Contact to specialist care for advice if required

Mallu: The mobile clinic

- Nurses consultation
- Preventative dental healthcare
- · Health guidance
- Removing stitchesVaccinations included flu

Malla: Mobile laboratory services

- Blood samples
- ECG
- Collecting samples brought by patients
